

Station 2 — dictaphone recording → clean text + summary

Source file: przyklad-korpus/poznan-1956/relacje-swiadkow/relacja-01-surowa.txt

A raw record of a witness recording: no punctuation, full of “yyy”, “no więc”, no split between speakers.

Prompt (paste it, then paste the text from the file underneath)

This is a raw transcript of a witness recording in Polish. Turn it into readable text:

- add punctuation and paragraphs,
 - split it into turns (Witness / Interviewer),
 - remove speech stumbles ("yyy", "no więc", repetitions) without changing the meaning.
- At the end, add a 5-sentence summary.

What to expect: a ragged monologue turns into an ordered conversation split by role, plus a concise summary.

Harder variant — thematic coding and quotes

From this account, extract:

1. a list of thematic threads (codes), e.g. "working conditions", "violence", "memory";
2. one verbatim quote illustrating each thread.

Give the result as a table: thread | quote.

Why it matters in research: interviews, focus groups, meetings, testimony. This is the start of qualitative analysis — the equivalent of manual work in NVivo, only local and free.
